

Directions

For Satnav St Martin de Belleville 73440 seems to work - but don't let it send you up the old road from Moutiers - if you pass the right fork to the D117 as detailed below, and arrive at a roundabout with exits to the D915 for Meribel and Courcheval and the N90 for Aime and Bourg-Saint-Maurice, you've gone too far!

From **Chambery** follow **Albertville** then **Moutiers**.

From **Moutiers** take the road marked **Val Thorens** and **St Martin de Belleville** marked the **D117**. It's a fork to the right from the dual carriageway as you get into Moutiers. Take care here as you go from fast dual carriageway to a road with some serious hairpin bends! Follow this road past Villarly and St. Jean de Belleville and over a river bridge. You will pass a hamlet called Les Frenes, take a left hand hairpin and the La Rochette junction is on the following bend.

It's marked **Les Varcins** and is the **D96**. After less than 2km you will see the village of **La Rochette** on the right. Go up the slope into the village and park anywhere - Luke will show you our car parking spaces if necessary. If you do miss the turn you'll end up in St Martin de Belleville just up the road.

Chalet Broski is the highest building in the village - you should see a large snowflake on the front.

You can get maps from Google, but you need to put St Martin de Belleville in, not La Rochette. If you trace the D117 back down towards Moutiers you will see the junction in the hairpin and La Rochette marked after that.

Snow Chains

If there is snow on the road you are advised to have snow chains. The police sometimes check before letting you past Moutiers. Chains for normal wheels are available at many service stations and garages, but if you have unusual or large wheels it would be better to get some in the uk. They are very efficient at clearing the roads and you might never need to use chains, but we strongly advise you to be prepared.
